One Day at A Time...

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Hello, my name is Tami Floyd. My husband, Rick and I work as advocates to help individuals, their families, and their support people to navigate the system, find housing and provide support when they are still incarcerated and/or when they have returned to the community.

The following are some items that are helpful for us to know: *(Please answer those that apply)*

1. Complete a Release of Information – this is IMPORTANT if we need to check on anything regarding your case/situation.
2. **VERY IMPORTANT**- Has the paperwork been submitted for SS Card, birth certificate and ID? (Needed to get a job, bank account, driver's license, etc. and will cause **extreme** delay if you do not have them)
3. Case Manager's name's (first and last)
4. Status of Treatment? Are you in treatment now? If so, Therapist's name's (first and last)
5. Are you under Supervision? If so, PO's name.
6. Family/Support person(s) contact information.
7. Housing Needs (location, with or without roommate, etc.)
8. Financial Situation (savings, family support, etc.) How much do you have saved/available?
9. Occupational/Educational background (including what you have accomplished on the inside)
10. Are you a Veteran? If so, do you have a DD-214? Are you eligible for any veterans' benefits?
11. Are there any special needs or disabilities?
12. Do you have the SVP designation?
13. Was your offense against a child (needed for some of the housing)
14. Special conditions from Parole/Probation (sober living, transitional housing, location, etc.)
15. Have you been in contact with or are you working with any of the WAGEES programs? If so, which one?
16. Any Other Information you would like to share about yourself or your situation....

Once we have this information, we can begin to identify your needs and help in any way we can. Please understand, you will need to stay positive & patient as this process usually takes longer than we would like.

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
